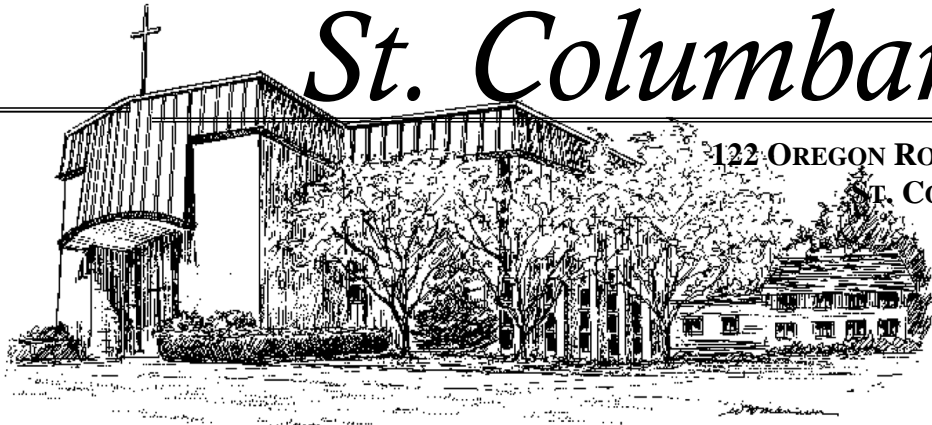

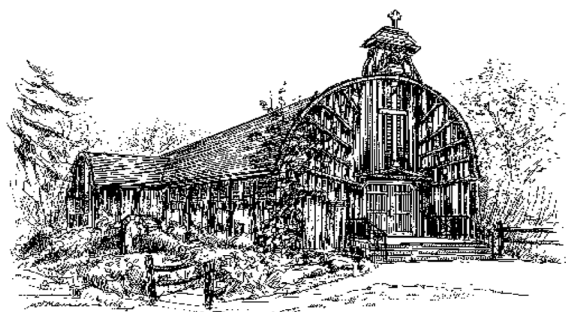

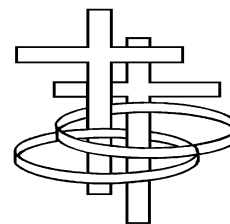

NOTES FROM OUR PASTOR . . .

*One of our parishioners pointed out that on satellite radio, Sirius XM, there is a Catholic station, channel 129. She listens to the daily Mass on the way to work and other prayers and Catholic shows. Please check it out.

*Did you know? Trinity Sunday, the first Sunday after Pentecost, was instituted to honor the Most Holy Trinity. In the early Church no special Office or day was assigned for the Holy Trinity. This may seem unusual but we must remember that the Trinity was always invoked at the conclusion of prayers by reciting Glory Be (this is still done at the recitation of the Divine Office). When the Arian heresy (4th century) was spreading, the Fathers prepared an Office with canticles, responses, a Preface, and hymns, to be recited on Sundays. In the Sacramentary of St. Gregory the Great there are prayers and the Preface of the Trinity. Pope John XXII (1316-1334) ordered the feast for the entire Church on the first Sunday after Pentecost.

*The doctrine of the Trinity, one God and three divine persons, is a basic tenet of the Christian faith. At the Mass, we call upon Father, Son, and Holy Spirit in the prayers. God is present in the Eucharist at Mass yet so few come to church. As the world crumbles before our very eyes, Catholics will have much to answer for as they prefer games, parties and shopping to worshipping the one true God - Father, Son and Holy Spirit - who is the source of all that is good, and to Him be all praise, honor and Glory forever. Amen.
