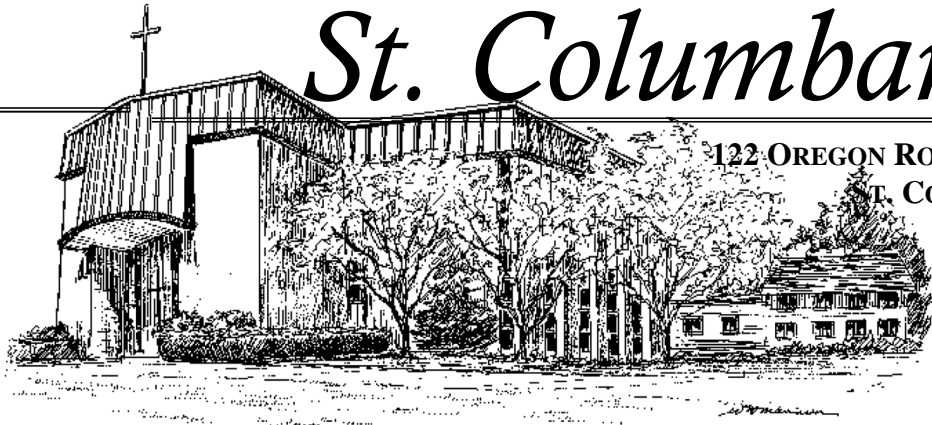

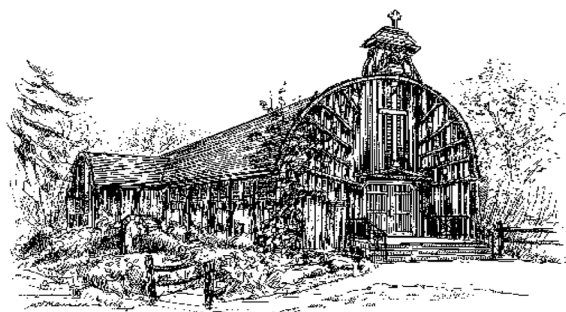
## **BAPTISM PROCEDURE:**

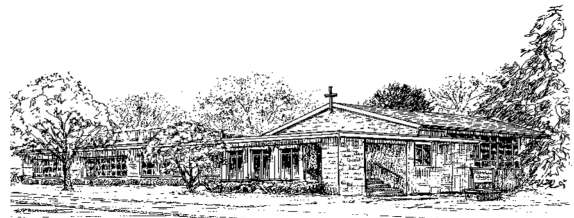

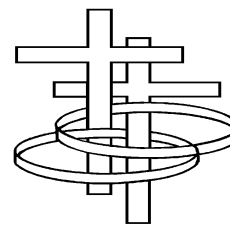
