NOTES FROM OUR PASTOR . . .

*Just a reminder that our parish picnic will be on Sunday, July 5th.

*The end of another school year and the beginning of summer vacation is upon us. We extend to all a safe and relaxing time. Let us remember that we shouldn't take a vacation from our Sunday Mass obligation, but should use the time to draw closer to God and one another through Mass, the sacraments, and family prayer. To deliberately miss Mass is a serious sin and one must go to confession before receiving Communion. To receive our Lord unworthily is itself a sin of sacrilege. Parents are responsible for their children going to Mass. Jesus said, "Whoever causes one of these little ones who believe [in me] to sin, it would be better for him if a great millstone were out around his neck and were thrown into the sea." (Mark 9: 42)

*God, our heavenly Father, has shown us His love by sending us His beloved Son. In turn, Jesus, "did not leave us orphans," but left us His true presence in the Blessed Sacrament at Mass and in the tabernacle in church. Every Monday from 7 to 8 p.m. we have exposition and benediction. Why not spend some time the spiritually refreshing presence of our Lord?

*We wish all dads a Happy Father's Day. Fatherhood is something special as it mirrors the divine paternity of God. The more I reflect on my father (and mother), the more my appreciation grows for them and all they sacrificed for "us kids." Seven (7) \$1,000 Third Prizes

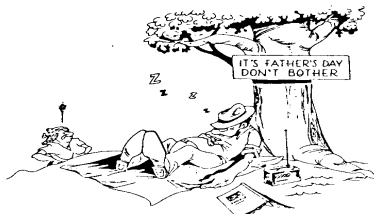
