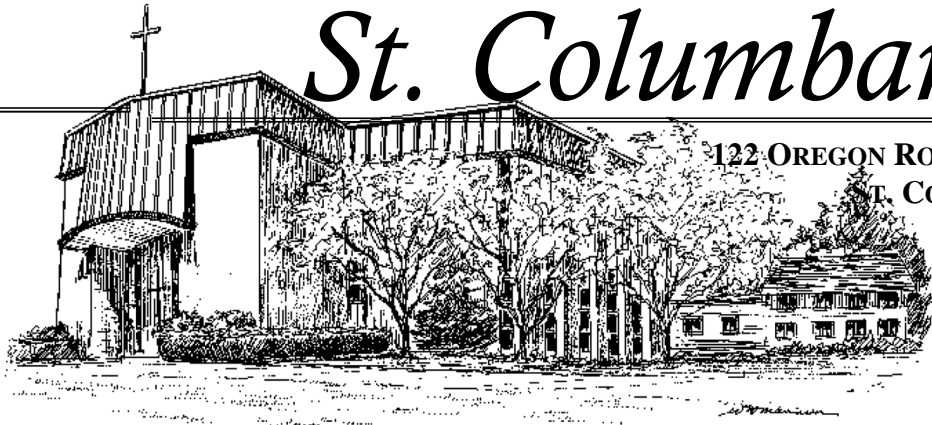

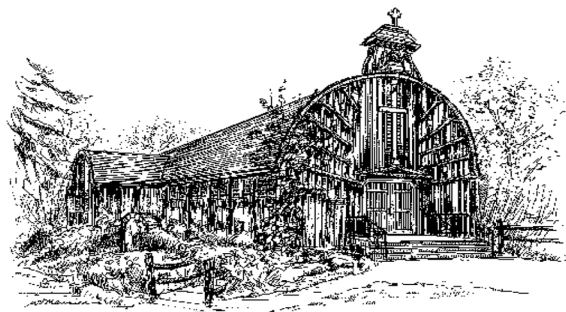

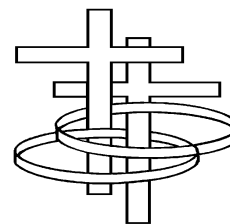

\*I received a letter from Cardinal Dolan assigning me to a second six-year term as pastor here at St. Columbanus. I wish to thank everyone who has been so kind to me. I will do my best, with God's help, to make our parish a vibrant, faith-filled community thankful for the gift of our Catholic faith and excited about passing on our faith to all we meet.

\*Thank you to all who responded to my FLOCKNOTE message asking for volunteers. I hope more parishioners will sign up for FLOCKNOTE to receive important messages by e-mail or text message regarding the parish and archdiocese. It's easy to sign up. Either text COLUMBANUS to 84576 or go to flocknote.com/Columbanus. We have less than 200 parishioners signed up. One neighboring parish has over 1,000 subscribers. Messages are only sent out for important information.

\*Along the same lines, I hope parishioners will also sign up for ParishPay to send their parish contributions electronically. You won't have to worry about remembering your envelope or catching up when you are away. It also lessens the work for our volunteers who enter the data into the computer for our records.

\*Last week I mentioned the young Virgin/Martyr St. Maria Goretti. A few days ago we celebrated St. Kateri Tekakwitha, a young native American who was baptized at the age of 20 and died at the age of 24 after living a life of great sacrifice and angelic purity. Our young people should be aware of the saints who are a shining example of the joy, holiness and happiness that can only be found by living a life in conformity to the will of God.
