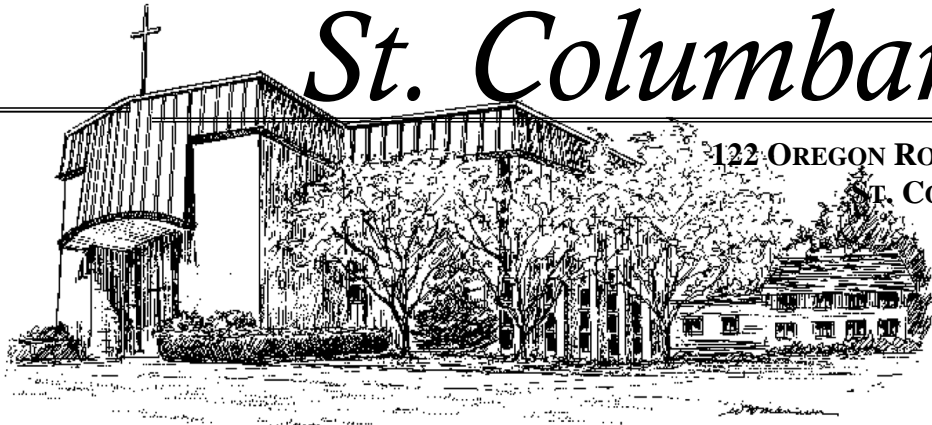

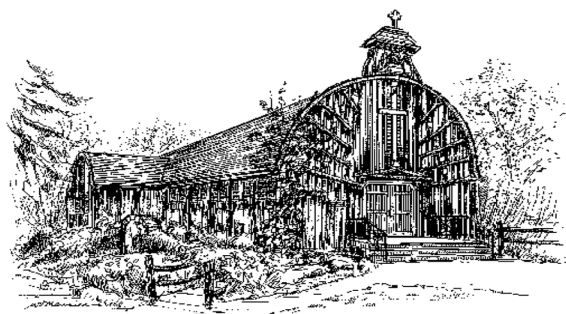
## **BAPTISM PROCEDURE:**

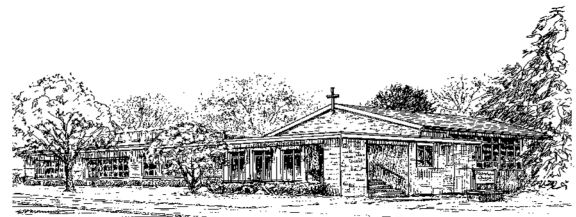

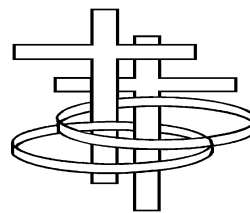

NOTES FROM OUR PASTOR . . .

I mentioned in my homily on Sunday the shocking news that Planned Parenthood (PP) sells body parts from aborted babies. This organization also has inroads in the public schools (I know, I worked for 14 years in a public high school). PP pushes contraception to students and provides abortion if (i.e. when) the contraception fails. They are an evil organization whose founder, Margaret Sanger, promoted contraception and abortion for eugenic purposes.
