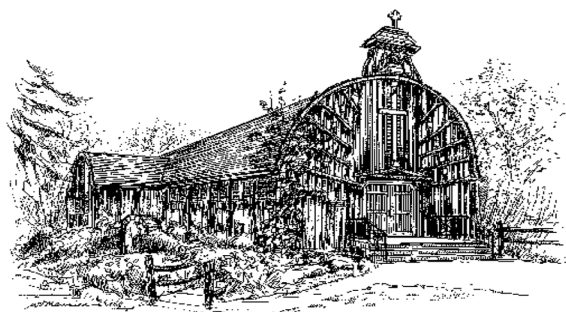

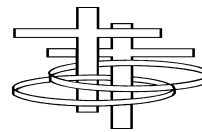

The day began with a prayer service and Exposition and Benediction of the Most Blessed Sacrament. Father Robert Quarato, pastor of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton parish, gave the address and led the assembly in meditation. The event concluded with the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass.

KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS NEWS

True happiness does not consist in pleasures of the world. Join us for a presentation on the life of Blessed Pier Giorgio on Saturday Nov. 7th at 7:15 p.m. He was a tremendous athlete who enjoyed skiing, biking, rowing, horseback riding, swimming, and mountain climbing. Most importantly, he never missed the chance to lead his friends in the attendance of Mass, reading Scripture, and praying the Rosary. The Holy Eucharist and the Blessed Virgin Mary were the two poles of his world of prayer. His spirit of self-giving was nourished by daily Communion and frequent nocturnal adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Pier Giorgio died at the age of 24. His funeral was a triumph, as the streets of the city were lined with a multitude of mourners who were unknown to his family. St. Pope John Paul II beatified Pier Giorgio, calling him the “Man of the Eight Beatitudes.” His mortal remains, found completely intact and uncorrupt upon their exhumation, were transferred to the cathedral in Turin, Italy. His feast day is celebrated July 4th.
